Who are we?

TalentEd brings together expert teachers and bright students from low income backgrounds in small groups to improve grades and future options.

The Programme

TalentEd sessions run for two hours after school every week over three terms. Every session starts with food and conversation, followed by carefully planned interactive tasks and reflection. Students develop self-awareness, study skills, aspirations and the ability to pursue future options.

How can you help?

TalentEd young people need inspirational University Student role models. In this role you will inspire and encourage students, support the tutor in the delivery of the session plan, and answer questions about your academic career and future plans. During the sessions, you may be given responsibility to lead a group activity, to work with an individual, or take part in an activity.

What's in it for you?

- Watching a group of bright Year 10 students develop each week and improve their self-awareness, aspirations and grades is rewarding and worthwhile.
- The role is especially valuable to those considering a future in education, as it gives you the opportunity to work with young people in a school setting and to learn from an expert teacher. Past volunteers have gone on to complete PGCEs and the Teach First programme, and have been told that their experience with TalentEd was an asset to their application.
- TalentEd would not want any volunteer to be out of pocket so we reimburse reasonable travel expenses
- We also carry out an enhanced Disclosure and Barring Services check allowing you to work with children
