TalentEd offers high-ability Year 10 students a year-long programme of weekly small group (1:6) sessions.

Improved GCSE grades

In one school, TalentEd pupils achieved **double the number of As & A*s** compared to a comparison cohort.

In another school, the average Progress 8 score of pupils who attended regularly was **7 points higher** than those who did not attend regularly.

90% of TalentEd students felt they had improved their study skills.
