### Case study: Andy

\*All names have been changed

Andy was a high achiever in primary school but struggled to maintain his high grades when he went to secondary school. Although he lost all confidence, it was clear that he was capable of achieving much more. Andy's narrative is common of bright students from disadvantaged backgrounds in the UK. For example, in 2015 the percentage of students receiving 5 A\*-C inc Maths and English in Andy's schools was 39 % which was considerably lower than that of the local authorities (54.79 %) and in the country (58.15). Furthermore, Andy is eligible for free school meals as his family earn less than £16,190.

Before he started the programme, Andy's grades ranged from F-C. When asked what he wanted from the programme, he said: 'I want to achieve Cs and above, though for many subjects that seems like a long shot'. After 9 impactful weeks working with his TalentEd tutor, Andy's grades had improved dramatically. He had achieved 10 A-C grades by the time he finished the programme.
